Developing Digital Services Infrastructures across Europe

Experience “digital public services across borders” at CeBIT 2015 from 16 to 20 March in Hanover!

Following the EU Commission’s vision of a ‘digital single market’, across Europe a number of innovative industry and public sector working groups are developing IT solutions that will simplify and speed up public services for citizens, business and state bodies across Europe.

The working groups, comprised of private companies and public sector bodies, are known as ‘Large Scale Pilot’ projects (LSPs) and are supported by the European Commission under the ICT Policy Support Programme as part of the Competitiveness and Innovation framework Programme (CIP).

The LSPs are contributing to the development of solid trans-European infrastructures based on mature technical and organisational solutions in the fields of e-Justice, e-Health, e-Procurement and e-Business. The aim is to make living, working, travelling, studying and doing business across borders easier.

Two projects are the focus of this year’s presentation at CeBIT. One, e-CODEX, is designed to provide secure e-Justice solutions. The newest LSP, e-SENS, aims to develop generic and re-usable IT ‘building blocks’ for digital services in Europe.

Through informative presentations and appealing gimmicks, visitors will be given an insight into this complex topic and come to understand the projects’ approach based on real-life scenarios. The comfortable and versatile stand design, with an interactive touch table, RFID-based information spots, a sliding monitor and an ice cream shack, offers the opportunity to get in contact with experts and other interested parties in a relaxed environment.
